June 14<sup>th</sup> is Flag Day, a day set aside to commemorate the adoption of Flag of the United States of America by the second continental congress on June 14<sup>th</sup> 1777. In 1907 the Grand Lodge of the Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks adopted a mandatory observance of the occasion. In 1916 President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation officially establishing June 14<sup>th</sup> as Flag Day and in 1949 National Flag Day was established by an act of congress.

The Iron Mountain Lodge #700 has a ceremony every year at the Iron Mountain VA hospital for the veterans and public. If you can help, please let Barney know, if not, come down and enjoy the ceremony with the vets anyway.
